Disposal Services can be accessed online at <u>SaskSurplus.ca</u>, by phone, email or in person. Vehicle and equipment sales occur tentatively on a monthly basis and start every second Wednesday and close at 10 a.m. on the third Wednesday of the month.

Work hours:

Monday to Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. with the exception of statutory holidays.

Declaration of surplus goods	Seller to submit disposal requests for goods by end of month, complete with accurate descriptions of goods and conditions and supporting pictures to be included in next month's sale.	Disposal Requests submitted 5 business days prior to the end of month will be posted in the following month's sale (or the seller has been addressed with corrections to be made on the Disposal Request).	95%	Reference File Number
Community Donations Postings	Donors to submit request to donate goods, complete with accurate descriptions of goods and conditions and supporting pictures to be posted on the Community Donations Program's website.	Community Donations Postings submitted by donors by Wednesday will be posted on the following Monday (or the donor has been addressed with corrections to be made on the posting submission).	90%	Report from CDP website with created and approval dates
